



- HB290 Representative Knight**  
**Summary:** General Fund Budget  
**STATUS:** Introduced 1/14 and referred to Government Appropriations Committee
- HB1/ SB225/ SB248 Representative Knight/Senator Sanders/Senator Beason**  
**Summary:** This bill would limit the federal income tax deduction from Alabama income tax and remove the state sales tax on food.  
**STATUS:** HB1 introduced 1/12 and referred to Education Appropriations Committee. SB225 and SB248 introduced 1/12 and referred to Finance and Taxation Education Committee.
- HB32/ SB79/ HB183 Representative Shiver/Senator Glover/ Representative Gaston**  
**Summary:** This bill would authorize the grandparent of a child to petition for visitation even if the parent has given up legal custody.  
**STATUS:** HB32, SB79, and HB183 introduced 1/12 and referred to Judiciary Committee. HB32 Judiciary Committee Substitute reading on 1/28.
- HB42/ HB47/ SB233 Representative Bentley/Representative Gipson/Senators Beason, Glover, Erwin, Smith, Sanford, Brooks, Holley and Pittman**  
**Summary:** This bill would amend the Constitution to prohibit mandatory participation in any health care system.  
**STATUS:** HB42 and HB47 introduced on 1/12 and referred to Health Committee. SB233 introduced on 1/14 and referred to Health Committee.
- HB88 Representative Gipson**  
**Summary:** This bill would exempt over-the-counter medications from sales tax.  
**STATUS:** Introduced 1/12 and referred to Education Appropriations Committee.
- HB101 Reps. Canfield, Ball, Drake, Treadaway, Williams (J) and DeMarco**  
**Summary:** This bill would provide for the establishment of a medical savings account.  
**STATUS:** Introduced 1/12 and referred to Education Appropriations Committee.
- HB104 Representative Williams (J)**  
**Summary:** Under existing law, any taxpayer who is over age 65 and who has an adjusted gross income of less than \$12,000 is exempt from county property taxes on the first \$5,000. This bill would increase the adjusted gross income amount to less than \$39,900.  
**STATUS:** Introduced 1/12 and referred to County and Municipal Government Committee.
- HB173 Representative Millican**  
**Summary:** This bill establishes the Patients' Bill of Rights relating to the disconnection of a ventilator.  
**STATUS:** Introduced 1/12 and referred to Health Committee.
- HB181 Reps. Love, Mask, Ison, Gaston, Sherer, Clouse, Sanderford, Wood, Hubbard, Faust, Wren, Beck, Hammon, Gipson, Canfield, Treadaway, McClendon, Ward, McClurkin, DeMarco, McCutcheon, Allen, Collier, Payne, Hill, Drake, Baker (A), Bentley, Greeson, McMillan, Oden, Thomas (E), Grimes, Fincher, Lewis, Johnson, Boothe, Laird and Ford**  
**Summary:** This bill would increase the state income tax deduction allowance for the cost of paying insurance premiums from 50% to 100%.  
**STATUS:** Introduced 1/12 and referred to Education Appropriations Committee.
